Truth Points: What truth was covered this weekend in the message?		
1.	How does this passage relate to Philippians 1:27–29? What is the difference in scope?	
2.	What are the four motivations for unity in verse 1? Describe each of them and why the Holy Spirit listed them. What are the four spiritual tuning forks for unity in verse 2? What do they mean? How does unity impact the personal joy of Paul? How does this relate to Hebrews 13:17?	
3.	What is a narcissist? According to James 3:13–18, does this have a tie to the wisdom of heaven or hell? How is this the natural state of humanity?	
4.	What does humility of mind mean and how does it work out in real life? Give examples of people who thought more highly of others.	
5.	Whose interest should you think about? Give some real-life examples.	

6. How does all this work in reality? How does it work when you have to lead? Have to follow? Must be godly among your peers? Give examples in your home, your workplace, our church family, or in the community.
